

## ADMISSION PROCESS



### 1. ADMISSION:

The minimum age for admission in Nursery is Three years. Age for admission to other classes is correspondingly. At present classes run from Nursery to XII. The medium of teaching language is English. The School follows the syllabus and Session of Central board of Secondary Education (C.B.S.E.) New Delhi.

### 2. REGISTRATION:

Registration Form and Prospectus will be available in the School office from 1st December on Payment of Rs.

500/- (Five Hundred Rupees Only) in Cash. The cost of prospectus and registration fee shall not be refunded under any circumstances. At the time of Admission the birth certificate, transfer certificate (T.C) with one passport size photograph, Aadhar Card of the candidate & Aadhar Card of Father & Mother is to be submitted in the school.

### FOR HOSTEL:

Two Passport size photographs of father and mother along with the admission form. Medical Fitness Certificate of Student. Two photographs of that person who will come to meet his/her ward.

The practical classes have been provided in the daily routine for the students. Kids are taught with audio-visual aids.

## 9. MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION:

The medium of instruction at the school is english.

## 10. COMPUTER:

Computer classes have been made compulsory from Std-I onwards.

## 11. SCHOOL BUS:

- The school bus facility is available for different routes. Bus fee is charged separately.

## 12. CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

To draw forth the hidden and creative talent of the children we conduct co-curricular activities which comprises debate, quiz, art & crafts, calligraphy, cultural activities weekly. At the end of the successful session participants are awarded with certificates.

## 13. EXCURSION:

Students are set on educational trip every year in two different group preferably to historical places, hill stations, biological parks etc.

## 14. PARENTS' S DAY:

There will be parents-teachers meet every month on first saturday. It is must for all the parents to attend this meet.

## 15. PARENTS VISITING DAY: (For Hostel)

1. Parents/guardians are allowed to meet their wards only on 1st & 3rd sunday of every month between 10:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.
2. Meeting with ward (s) is arranged only in "meeting hall".
3. Parents/guardians are earnestly requested not to wish to see their ward (s) on any school working day unless it is imperative.

**Hostel visit timing 10:00 A.M. To 1:00P.M.  
(Except Saturday & Sunday)**

## 16. CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

1. Vulgarity in behaviour, causing damage to school property, breach of discipline, ill-talking and use of intoxication materials are strictly prohibited in the school campus. If any student found doing so, he/she will be immediately expelled without any notice.
2. Involvement of any student in any criminal activity after being admitted to the school shall also be treated on legal terms and action will be taken accordingly.
3. Students are not permitted to keep radio, wrist watch, i-pad, camera, walkman, mobile and any other costly items with him/her in the school campus.
4. You can not take any edible items like dry fruits, snacks, fast food any type of soft drinks from your parents/guardians.

## 17. MEDICAL:

In case of illness, medical treatment is managed by the school management and the expenses incurred in this process are charged from the parents later.



## 18. MODE OF PAYMENT:

1. The fee must be paid in the 2nd month on or before 30 of the current month and next month together.
2. After 30th fine will be charged
3. The fee can be paid quarterly & half yearly

## 19. TUTORIAL CLASSES:

The institution organises tutorial classes time-to-time for the needy students to sharpen proficiency without charging extra fee.

## 20. PROGRESS REPORT:

1. Parents/guardians will be informed of the academic progress of their wards.
2. Examinations are conducted during the academic year:-  
1st periodic.....May  
Half yearly.....September  
2nd periodic.....December  
FINAL EXAM.....March
3. Weekly test are conducted for all subjects.
4. Promotion is granted on the basis of the whole year's performance.

## 21. WITHDRAWALS:

1. Withdrawals from any class must be preceded by a written notice or clearing all the dues before a month in lieu of notice.
2. All dues will have to be cleared before a transfer certificate is issued.
3. Transfer certificate will be issued after two days of receiving the application.
4. A fee of Rs. 100/- will be charged for issuing a duplicate copy of the transfer certificates and the

parents will have to submit an affidavit about the loss of the original certificate.

## 22. GENERAL INSTRUCTION TO THE PARENTS:

1. Parents are advised to send their wards to school in proper uniform. No student will be allowed to join the class, if he/she is not in proper uniform.
2. Parents are requested to pay charge for excursion, picnic etc.
3. Parents are also requested to contact the principal regarding the progress of the wards living in school-hostel to discuss any academic problem and its possible solution.
4. Parents are again requested to take part in "parents-teachers" meet and make the meet affirmative.

## 23. IMPORTANT NOTES.

1. All parents/guardians may please note that the contingency as given in the prospectus are liable to change with or without prior notice by the school administration depending upon administrative successful contingencies or exigencies arising at any time.
2. Clarification, if any, given by the school way of interpretation to the various clauses contained in the prospectus shall be tenable at medininagar court only.


